Tony writes about creating a challenging and fun environment for coaches; parents, and most importantly players in his book **“Catch Them Being Good”**.

“The components of excellence which we find on all great teams are the same components needed to create successful youth programs which focus on educating the total child.

These components include expectations, shared visions, developing leaders and positive character traits as well as technical skills and all the while keeping it fun.”

Tony DiCicco coached the United States Women's National Soccer Team from 1994 -1999, during which time the team won the 1996 Olympic Gold Medal and the 1999 FIFA Women's World Cup against China.

In 2007, DiCicco was named head coach of the Boston Breakers, whose first home game will be April 12, 2009 at Harvard Stadium.

Most recently, DiCicco coached the U.S. U-20 Women's National Team to victory in the 2008 FIFA Women's U-20 World Cup in Chile, and was awarded the NSCAA 2008 Award of Excellence.
